Connie Q. Hadley was a faithful community leader with an emphasis on youth, education, helping those in need and growth of the community. She shared her knowledge and gave of her time willingly to the cities of Edwardsville and Bonner Springs, Kansas. For the last 23 years of her life (1997-2020) she was a foster grandparent at the Edwardsville Elementary School. She was known as Grandma. During those years she also helped judge senior projects, was on the Board of Education & was an instrumental part of community planning and activities.

Qualifications for Scholarship:

1. Student must have attended Edwardsville Elementary at least 1 school year.
2. Have applied for admission to college, university or technical school.
3. Submit an essay of 100-150 words on what you can, will or have done to help other people and/or your community.
4. Submit an introduction of yourself (in any style you choose i.e. letter, memo, list, creative formats). This introduction must include:
 - (a) Your name
 - (b) Year(s) attended Edwardsville Elementary
 - (c) Where you have applied for post-secondary schooling
 - (d) GPA
 - (e) Your goals, intended course of study and any other information you wish to share

You will be notified within 48 hours by email that your application has been received. If you do not get an acknowledgement, please re-send or contact your school counselor.

This scholarship does not have any income, specific course of study nor GPA restrictions.

One scholarship will be given for \$500 and another for \$250. In the event there is only one qualified person then the entire \$750 will be awarded to that person. Also at the discretion of the committee and available funds, additional scholarships may be awarded.
