

Charlene and Dewayne Kerby Scholarship

Background

Charlene and DeWayne Kerby were sister and brother live-long residents of Bonner Springs. Both graduates of Bonner Springs Senior High School with a commitment to making a good living, to family and to neighbors. Charlene's career was at Colgate-Palmolive. DeWayne's career was custodian at Bonner Springs Senior High School. The Kerby Family honors their work ethic and impact on the community with this scholarship.

Criteria

Purpose: The Charlene and Dewayne Kerby Scholarship is awarded to a Bonner Springs Senior High School graduating senior to continue their education at a community college or technical school focusing on a skilled occupation requiring experience and specialized training within a formal education environment.

Criteria: To be Eligible the student will:

- Be a senior student in good standings at Bonner Springs High School;
- Receive their diploma at the end of the current academic year;
- Attend a community college or technical school to gain experience and training for an occupation requiring specialized skills;
- Submit a resume relating interest, identifies their career choice, describes their interest in their career choice, the name of the community college or vocational school they will attend and their future plans;
- Include one letter of recommendation from an individual who is a member of the school faculty or staff.
- Submit your documentation to the Scholarship Committee for Bonner Springs High School by end of day designated as the Local Scholarship deadline.

Guidelines: Scholarship will be awarded in two installments by the Education Foundation when the student provides to the Education Foundation:

- Proof of enrollment.
- Second year, proof of enrollment with first year G.P.A no lower than 2.5 and is a student is good standing.

Amount: Each year the Charlene and Dewayne Kerby Scholarship will award \$2,000. The award will be paid in two equal installments.

Deadline: To be determined by the Scholarship Committee.
